The DFG-funded research Formove-I and Formove-II

From 2019 to 2022, Formove-I focused on the dynamic and interplay of forced migration and organized violence in Mexico and Turkey. From 2022 to 2025, Formove-II concentrated on analyzing forced migrants' future plans, particularly with regard to the options of returning, moving on or staying in Jordan, Turkey, Colombia and Mexico. More than 1,200 migrants were surveyed, collected more than 70 autobiographical narratives and carried out expert interviews and ethnographic visits. By this, Formove-I and Formove-II combined mixed methods in data gathering and analysis, embedding migrants' agency within a complex conceptual framework that considers both macro- and micro-contexts.
